# Help bring butterflies home to your garden

Native wildflowers are adapted to local climate and soils and require less care and watering once established. They provide sugar-filled nectar and protein-rich pollen for beneficial insects like local butterflies and wild bees. This regional native plant list includes wildflowers for the PEI ecozone, which includes: **All of PEI, Charlottetown and Summerside.** Always try to find local sources for native plants.

| Canada Goldenrod        | <i>Solidago Canadensis</i>         | 0.6-2.1m     | Yellow                      | Aug – Nov     | Partial shade          | Moist                      | Bees, butterflies               |
| Calico Aster            | <i>Symphyotrichum Lateriflorum</i> | 0.3-1.2m     | White/cream                 | Aug – Oct     | Sun to partial shade   | Dry to moist               | Butterflies                     |
